If you or someone in your family has a job you would like to talk to the children about, please speak to the class teacher.












































COVID-19

Also, please discourage fingers and hands in the mouth. This is spreading germs around all the toys and furniture. Thank you.




CRIS are hosting a reunion night in the Lansdowne Hotel, 6th October 6:30-10pm for all parents who have been involved in Shared Education with the school.
